

Cases of revision of PPOs of pre-2016 retired Running Staff (NWR)

(i) Shri Chandra Prakash Parnami, Mail/Express Loco Pilot, Jaipur Division:

- PPO No. 20157331100556 (7th CPC)
- Superannuated on 31/05/2015.
- Original Pension – Rs. 23646 from 01/06/2015.
- Notional Fixation of Pay as per illustration of Railway Board's letter dated 24/01/2018, Pay Rs. 47290+125% Rs. 59113+32% = Total Rs. 1,21,536.
- Concordance Table No. 21 do not cover more than Rs. 1,12,400. Therefore, in the PPO this amount has been written in the column meant for national pay in the revised PPO.
- Actually, pension being paid Rs. 23646 x 2.57 = Rs. 60771.

(ii) Shri Lallu Lal Sharma, Loco Shunter, Jaipur Division, Pay Scale Rs. 5000-8000, retired/died on 27/11/2000:

- PPO No 20007331100154 (7th CPC).
- Lat Pay (5th CPC) = Rs. 5900
- +55% of pay = Rs. 3245
- Pay for retirement benefits = Rs. 9145

6th CPC

- Pay – 5th CPC = Rs. 9145
- DA 86% = Rs. 7865
- Fitment = Rs. 4200
- Total = Rs. 21210

7th CPC

- Pay in 6th CPC = Rs. 21210
- DA 125% = Rs. 26513
- Fitment 32% = Rs. 06788
- Total = Rs. 54511

As per PPO of 6th CPC family pension was calculated Rs. 202 after multiplying by 2.57, it comes to Rs. 15940 but in the revised PPO it has been reduced to Rs. 15600 which is wrong as they pension already being paid should not be reduced.

(iii) Smt. Dayavati Dixit w/o late Shiv Kumar Dixit, Mail Guard, Jaipur Pay Scale Rs. 1600-2600, superannuated on 31/07/1994 – PPO No. 19947331100198:

- Last Pay in 4th CPC = Rs. 2100
- +55% of pay = Rs. 1155
- Rs. 3255

(for calculation of retirement benefits)

5th CPC

- Pay in 5th CPC = Rs. 3255
- DA 148% = Rs. 4818
- IR (i) = Rs. 100
- IR (ii) 10% of pay = Rs. 326
- Rs. 8499

6th CPC

- Pay = Rs. 8499
- DA 86% = Rs. 7309
- Fitment = Rs. 4200
- Rs. 20008

7th CPC

- Pay = Rs. 20010
- DA 125% = Rs. 25013
- Fitment 32% = Rs. 6404
- Notional Pay = Rs. 51427

As per Pay Matrix of concordance table No. 21 family pension comes to Rs. 15600. In the revised PPO the normal family pension has been given Rs. 15150. In fact, notional pay has not been calculated but amount of Rs. 50500 has copied out from the concordance table.
