
Sir/Madam

C.A. REFERENCE CASE NO. 5 OF 1993

Having heard the submissions of the representatives of both the parties at length, examined the entire materials on record presented by the parties, and given our most anxious and careful consideration thereto and to all relevant facts and circumstances having bearing on the matter in issue between the parties, we hereby give our Award as follows :

The Post Office Staff (i) who attend counter duties to handle cash as a regular measure and (ii) those engaged in disbursing salaries/bills/pension as a regular measure (excluding Treasurers/Asst. Treasurers) by receipts and disbursements shall get cash handling allowance at the following rates:

Amount of cash handled on an average per day	Cash handling Allowance (Rs. per month)
Rs.10,001 to Rs.20,000	Rs. 15/-
Rs.20,001 to Rs.50,000	Rs. 20/-
Rs.50,001 to Rs.1,00,000	Rs. 25/-
Above Rs. 1,00,000	Rs. 30/-

Such Allowance would be admissible to such Post Office Staff working for a minimum of 16 days in a month on a pro-rata basis for the period employed in such duties.

This Award shall take effect from the 1st day of July, 1999.
